While scouring the internet in search of intriguing new instrumental music, I found myself surrounded by a seemingly endless catalog of non-obtrusive audio events that Brian Eno might call "ambient music". As I listened to a sampling, I began to wonder about the meaning of that label. To better understand the word, I asked myself, "What is its opposite? What is excluded? What is everything else?"

This piece, *Everything Else*, is an exploration of these questions. Its six parts are a reminder of a few places that lie beyond the confines of ambience. The music is tied together by a common thematic thread, running through a series of different treatments, sometimes getting lost altogether before returning.
